These instructions are used to assist the Teacher with the use of Cultural Connections: A game about the Spanish-Speaking World.



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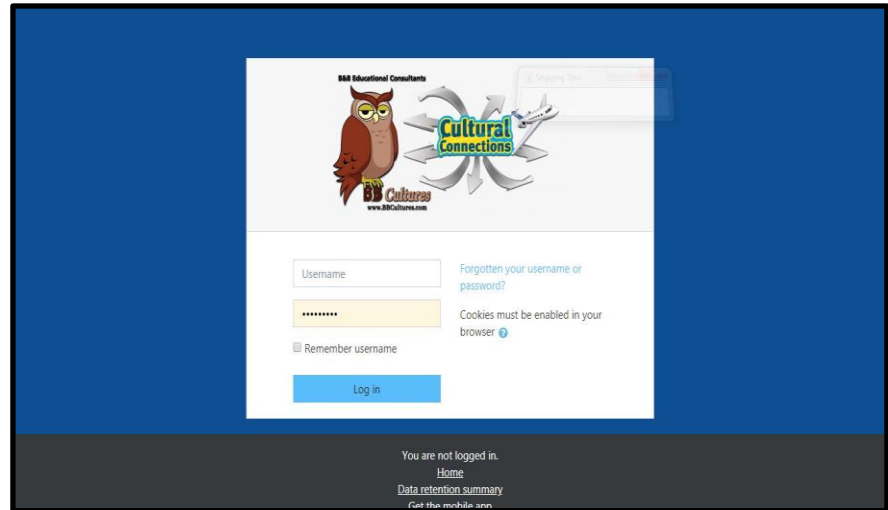
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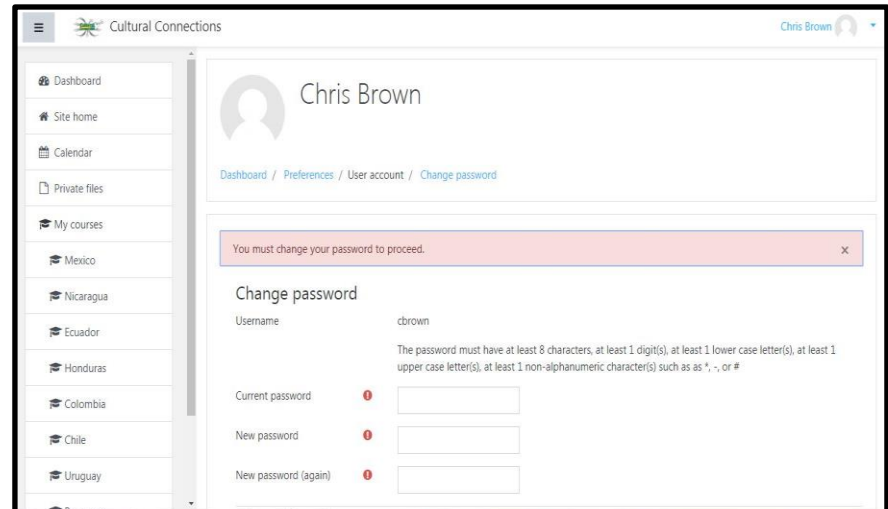


Welcome to Cultural Connections

Your site administrator has created a teacher username and password for you. Please use this username to log into Cultural Connections to start exploring Spanish speaking countries.



The first time you log into Cultural Connections, you will be forced to change your password.





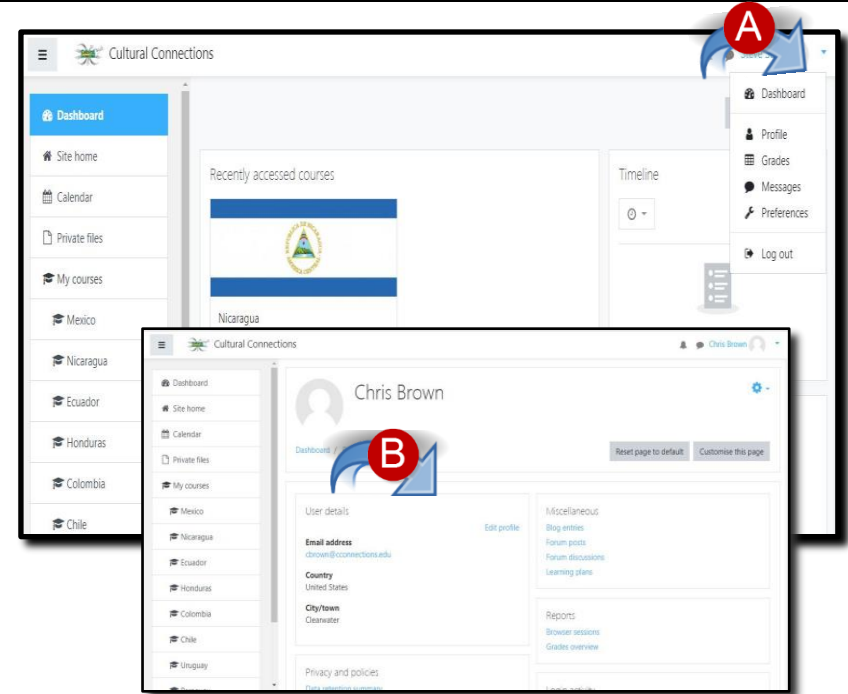
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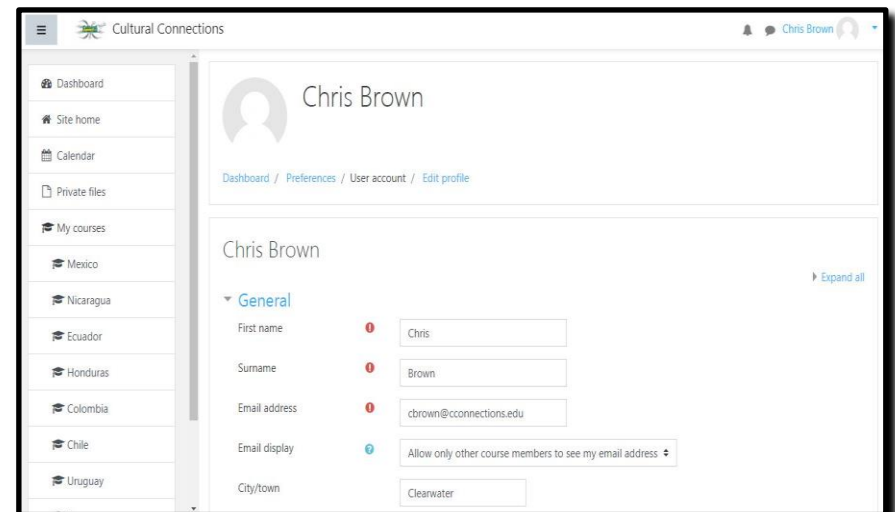


After you change your password, you will be offered a tour of the course.

After the tour, please update your profile. Select the down arrow (A) in the top right, select profile from the drop down menu. Next, select Edit Profile (B) and update with your information.



Make sure to include your correct Email address.





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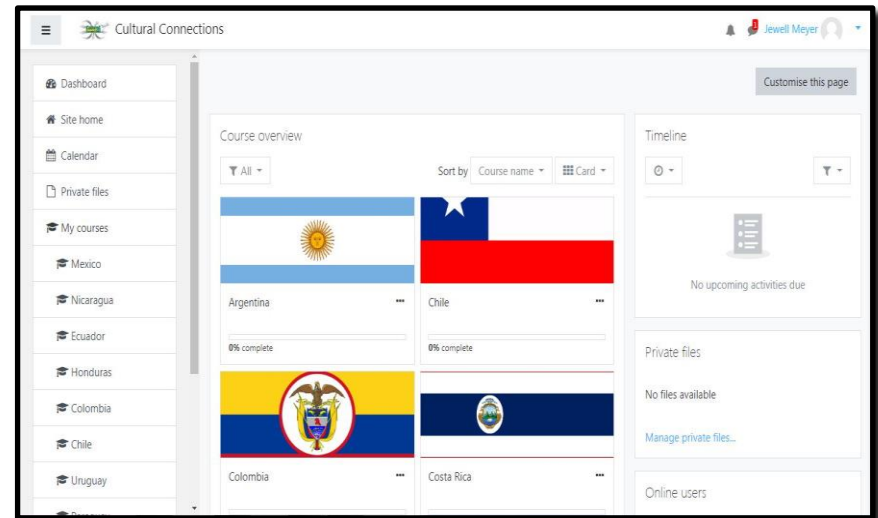
Cultural Connections Layout

The teacher dashboard is divided into three sections.

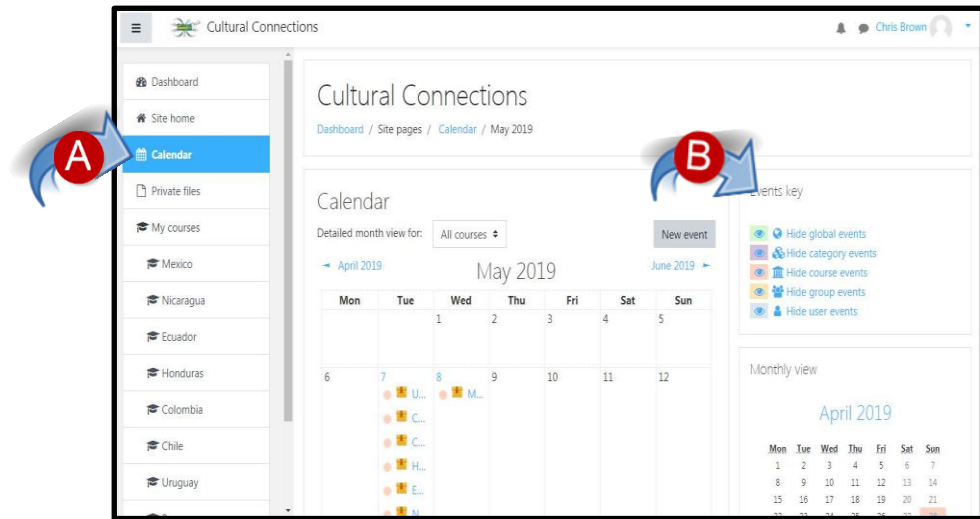
The left side is the menu for quick access to the various parts of the page.

The center is where the courses are displayed and easily accessed.

The right gives access to the user's private files, timeline for the course and shows if any users are online.



Use the calendar to set the order you would like the students to tour each country. Select Calendar (A) on from the left panel and then select New Event (B)





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Enter the start date for the country, then select the course from the drop down box.

This will show on all students' calendars in the program.

If you wish to add more details, select show more (A)

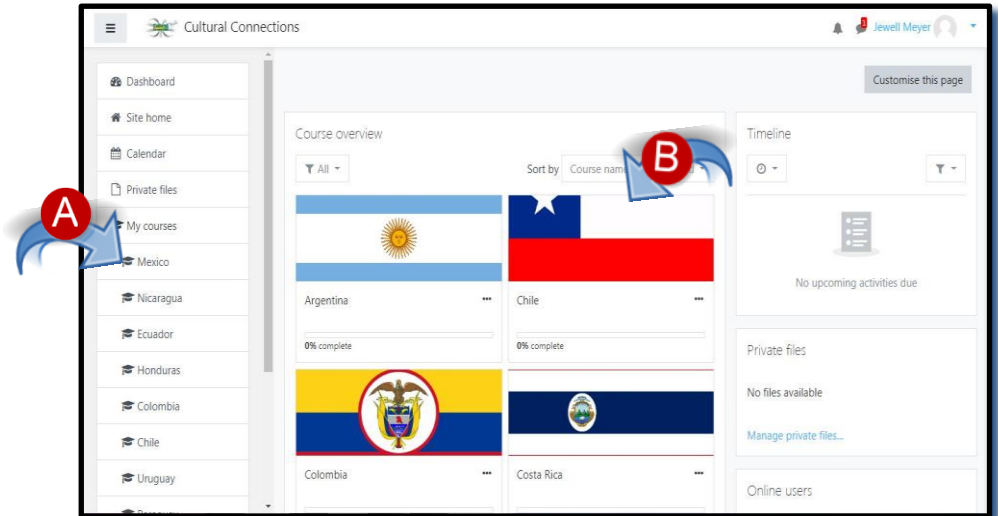
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Entering Cultural Connections

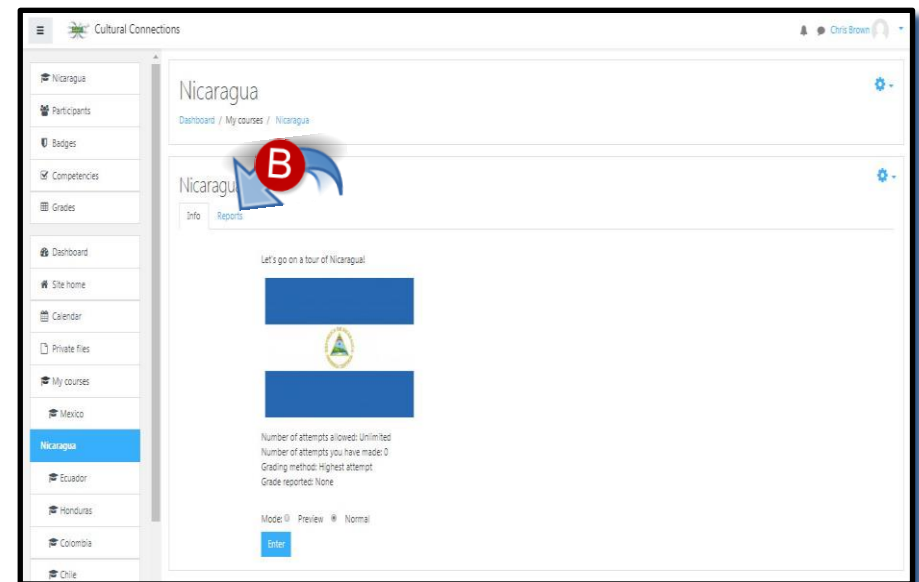
Courses can be seen either on the left navigation panel (A) or in the center, Course Overview (B).



Select the country of your choice by double clicking on it.

From here, you have two choices. You can enter (A) the country and explore it as a student, or you can select to view the reports (B).

Let's enter and explore the country.





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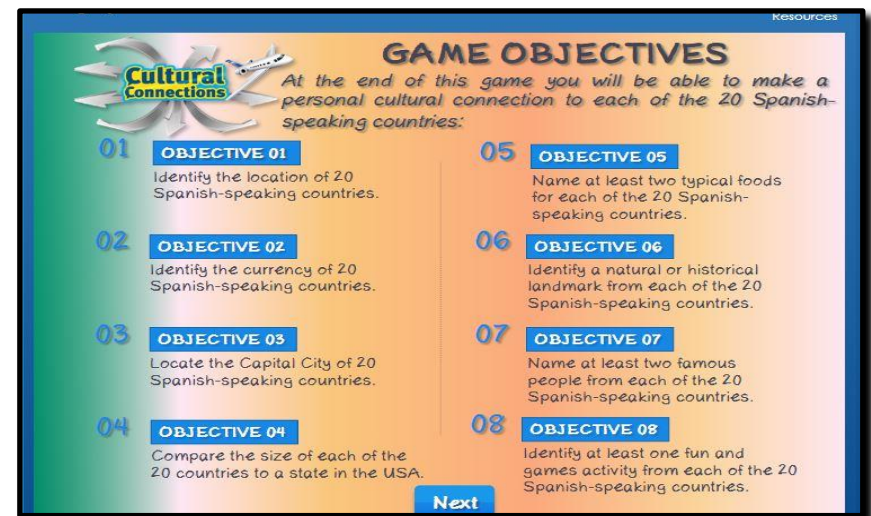

Proceed through the game by following the instructions, answering questions and earning Fly Miles along the way.





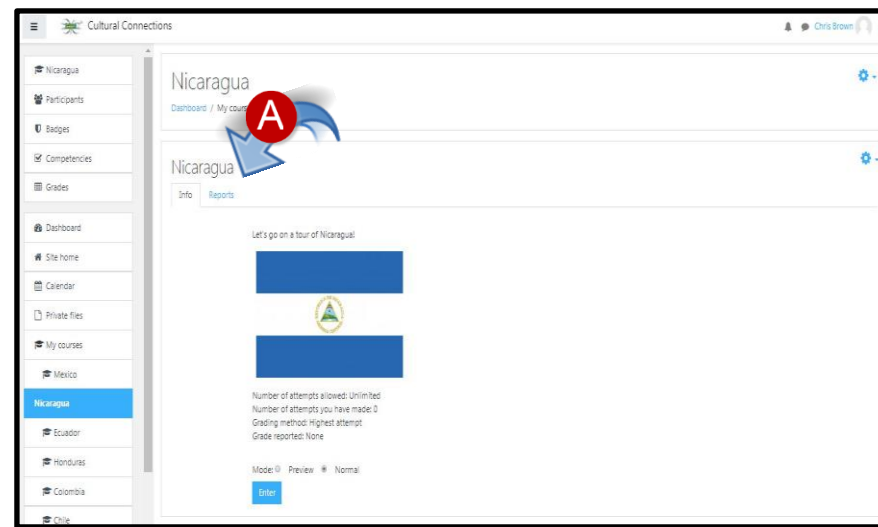
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Viewing Student Reports

Select the Reports tab at the top of the Cultural Connections Game.(A)



There are different reports available:

- Basic report shares the student's attempts and their final score.
- The Graph Report compares the number of students and their percentile scores.
- The Interactions Report shows the different answers that the student gave.
- The Objective Report shows how the student did with each objective.
